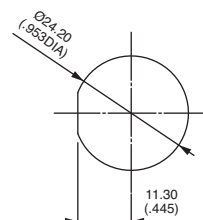

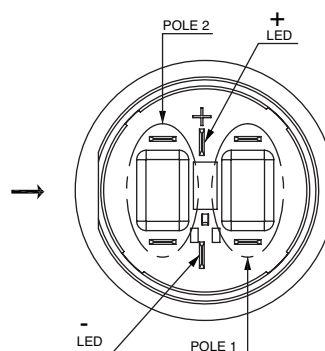


PANEL CUT-OUT

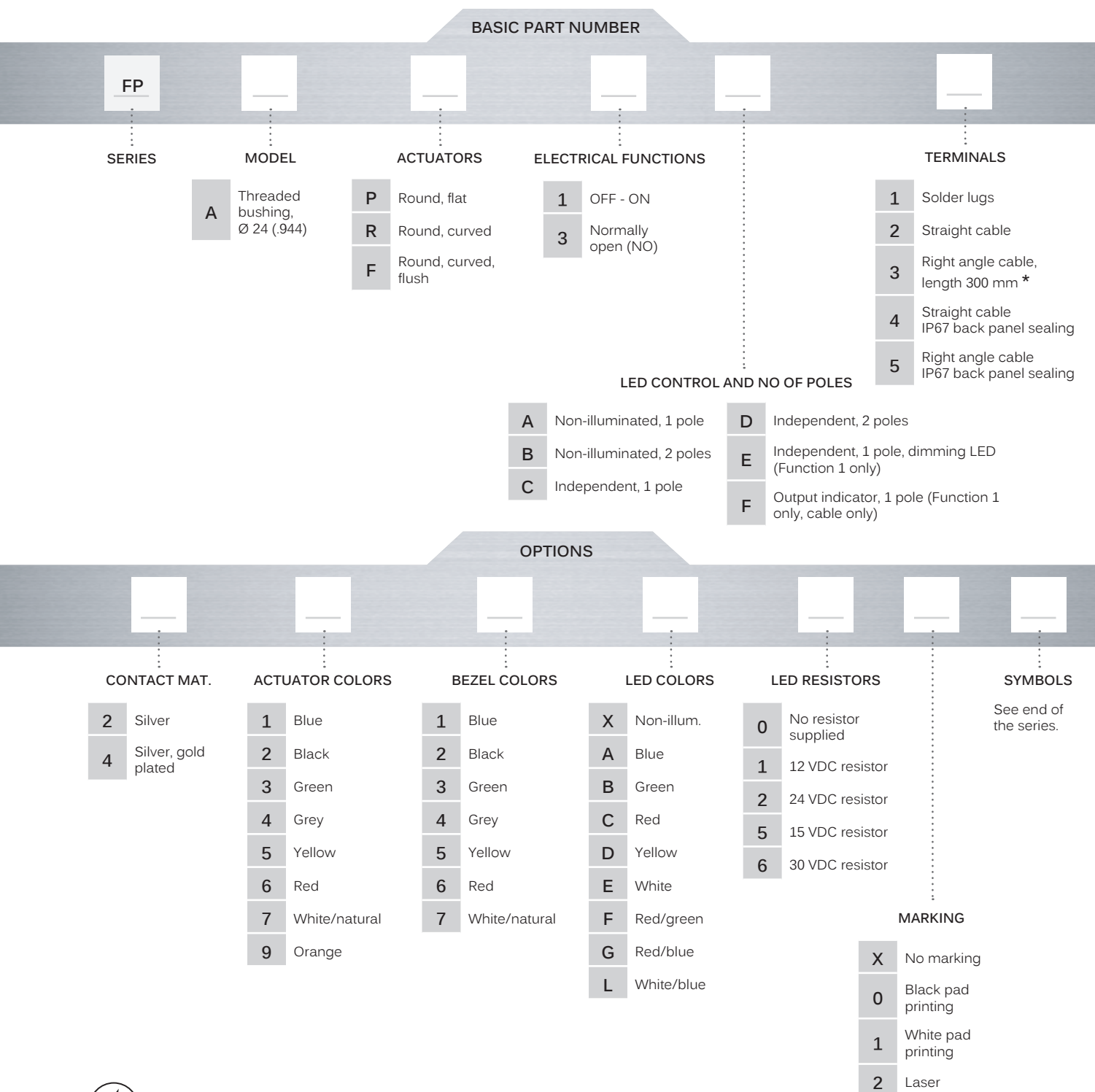
